Despite maximums from both Joe Haines and Mark Hudson this week The Phoenix Tap A do appear to be coming off the top of their recent good form as they allowed an improving Red Lion to come back and claim a draw. In an evenly contested affair the draw came courtesy of a stand out last leg to avoid the defeat by Ralph Cox and albeit he's in his 70's these days the old feller can still get the job done.

The Blue Bell have also been doing well but they came royally unstuck against Whitley Lodge B who's better scoring throughout across all six players made all the difference. They move into 3rd place on the back of this and should continue to threaten in the top three as they continue to settle as a side.
