The Grey Horse won the Shiremoor derby match taking it eight points to four in what was reported as a really competitive encounter. This was a result the Horse needed and it keeps them in seventh but still in touch with those above them whilst the Blue Bell drop one place to ninth.

The Seahorse B march on with some superb darts including 26 ton plus scores, a max each for Geordie Edger and Paul Hodge along with 130 check out but it has to be said that the Fat Ox defied expectation along with the form book by coming back from seven one down. In the face of those stats they still took three of the six remaining singles points and that result sees the gap increase between the Seahorse B and the Victoria at the top of the table.

The Victoria are well aware of the pressure the 2017-18 champions can exert but they are also playing really well and they claimed a double figure haul at home to Whitley Lodge A in a match which included 22 ton plus scores and a 17 dart leg from Simon Malpass. Whitley Lodge A are another side who are yet to find any consistent form.

The Red Lion are however finally beginning to as they took a double figure result against Seahorse A who were admittedly understrength as they has a couple of their regulars unavailable. Take nothing away from the Earsdon side though as they were solid all the way through the match.

Tynemouth Club enjoyed a cracker of a game played in a great spirit as they hosted the Phoenix Tap B and the Tap B put in their best performance of the season so far to fight back and take four of the six singles to claim the draw.

The Phoenix Tap A held off Marden Club in a tight contest and climb back into 4th as a result. Steve Ritson bagging a maximum but even so Marden Club clearly have not hit any real form yet so expect them to stay in the mix once they do.

Last this week and what a belter of a match it was as the Whitley Lodge B boys overcame an excellent effort from the Border Terrier who were 5 - 1 up going into the singles but the Lodge B rallied under the pressure and taking their cue from the maximum by Gary Wilson won all six singles to run out winners. A brilliant night thoroughly enjoyed by both sides.
