After a good start The Blue Bell are finding it hard to find another win and this week lost to an excellent display from Tynemouth Club. Micky Armstrong hitting a 14 darter and Tommy Charlton getting a maximum to lift them up a place while the Bell slip a place the other way.

The Snooker Club B are also in good early season form and took no prisoners in their double figure away win at The Fat Ox to stay in contention in 3rd place. Two lovely ton plus finishes from Messrs Fitzgibbon and Matthews among a host of high scoring from the visitors. The Fat Ox have yet to settle in the new venue it would appear and slide another place on the back of this loss.

Marden Club took full advantage of a surprisingly understrength turn out by The Grey Horse and helped themselves to a lift up one place back into 5th including a maximum for Greg Falcus and a good checkout by Mattie Richardson. The Grey Horse slip further down and need to be able to get the full six players on the oche week in, week out to arrest the dip they are having.

The Red Lion are proving to be draw specialists with their third 6-6 result in as many weeks and this time it was they who were 5-1 ahead going into the singles only to see an excellent fight back occur from the Snooker Club A lads and by the end they fully deserved to have pulled it level.

In the first of a trio of 11-1 results The Seahorse B did all they could to maintain the pressure on the leaders including another Geordie Edger maximum to run out comfortable winners against the Phoenix Tap B, who whilst struggling at the bottom continue to give it their all in every match. Indeed it could be argued that taking a point out of last seasons champs is a result in itself for them.

In the reverse stablemates derby stakes The Seahorse A were on the wrong end of it despite a Paul Dytham maximum as The Phoenix Tap B took eleven points and in doing so show they are the most unpredictable team form wise. Steve Adam continues his high standard and the result keeps them at the head of the chasing pack in 4th place whilst The Seahorse A remain in 13th.

The Victoria are staying ahead of everyone else and showed again this week that they are real contenders. You can't go to The Border Terrier and take eleven points if your not on your game as the Marden estate crew are no push overs especially at home so this could be considered one of the results of the season. All players across both teams played well with Connor Jones hitting a maximum and Michal Wood loads of ton plus scores to keep things very interesting at the top.
