The Blue Bell suffered the dreaded brush at the hands of the leaders Victoria who now move five points clear with five games remaining which represents a healthy lead for them and makes it harder for the challengers. Taking nothing away from the Vic it's clear that The Blue Bell are in a poor spell of form and as a result are dropping away in twelfth place with an eight point gap to the Lodge A.

The Border Terrier were on fine form and took a strong home win at Hartingdon Road to the Seahorse A evidenced by good ton plus scoring and no messing on the doubles.

A smashing 121 checkout by Christian Hollier (on his birthday) could not stop a Fat Ox defeat at home to Marden Club. Good to see Craig McVay registering a singles win against Spanner in the last singles as he steps in to cover missing players in a clearly understrength Marden side this season.

Whitley Lodge Snooker Club A bounced back from last weeks draw with a double digit result at bottom side Phoenix Tap B with a maximum coming from Paul Anderson and a 105 checkout from Chris Barnfather helping the home side to a point.

Despite multiple maximums from the usual suspects for The Seahorse B they still faced dogged resistance from Phoenix Tap A who took two and a half points to allow the gap between first and second to grow. Reports from the match indicate that the home side probably couldn't have played any better so maybe it's just not going to be their season this time around. The Tap A remain in fourth but The Grey Horse are closing the gap on them courtesy of an excellent win away in Tynemouth. Maximums from Hass and Sean Brown helped but the standard was clearly high throughout the team looking at the scoring. For the home side Tommy Charlton continues his comeback form with a seventeen darter.
