Marden Club bagged some much needed points this week as they visited the Phoenix Tap B to ensure they stay clear ahead of neighbours The Border Terrier, but it's good to see the bottom side hitting some ton plus out shots courtesy of Lewis Austen.

The Seahorse B allowed a really good chance to close the gap at the top even further slip through their fingers as they were sitting 7 zip up on the back of some really consistent and punishing high scoring. Up to the first singles the Red Lion were not within a 150 in any leg and could not see where a point would come from but then the home team began to miss doubles and the visitors gladly took the chances given.
